2017 NAFOW Tour Descriptions

1. Thursday, August 31, 2017, Erie Canal and George Eastman House

Price: \$75.00, Entrance fees and catered lunch are included in the price. Assemble at 8:45 in the hotel lobby, tour will leave by 9:00am, and return by 4:00pm.

Leaving the Hyatt Regency, you will take a short bus ride to Pittsford, NY. You will board the *Sam Patch* for a private cruise on the Erie Canal, traveling the routes of America's early settlers. Cruise aboard the *Sam Patch* and enjoy a leisurely adventure navigating one of America's most famous historic routes. *Sam Patch* cruises feature the signature canal experience of traveling through a century-old canal lock and passing through a beautifully restored and redeveloped historic canal town. During the cruise, you will be provided with a historical narrative that focuses on the construction of the Erie Canal, its impact on the region, and the relationship between the City of Rochester and the Canal.

Once the cruise is completed, the bus will take you to one of the most well-known addresses in Rochester, 900 East Ave. the George Eastman House. A catered lunch will be provided in the Curtis Theater. The historic mansion and gardens at the George Eastman Museum provide a glimpse into the life of one of the greatest American innovators and entertainers in the first decades of the twentieth century. Original furnishings and artifacts, careful reproductions, and beautifully restored landscape transport visitors to George Eastman's time. The Colonial Revival mansion, built between 1902 and 1905, served as George Eastman's primary residence until his death in 1932. You will receive a private guided tour of the Mansion and have time on your own to explore the extensive collections in the Eastman Museum.

2. Monday, September 4, 2017, Corning Museum of Glass, Rockwell Museum and Keuka Springs Winery

Price: \$80. Museum entry fees, a catered lunch and wine tasting included in the price. Assemble at 8:00 in the hotel lobby, tour will leave by 8:15am. Return by 6pm.

Leaving Rochester, you will drive through some of the most wonderful rural scenery that upstate New York has to offer. Upon arrival at the world-renowned Corning Museum of Glass, you will be met by a docent who will take you on a two hour tour of the vast facility. The museum was founded in 1951 as a gift to the nation for the Corning Glass Works 100th anniversary. The concept seems so simple. How much can you say about glass? Actually, quite a lot. Glass is a versatile, ancient material that is still being explored and understood by artists, scientists, and historians today. The story of glass is a story about art, history, culture, technology, science, craft and design. And we tell that story at The Corning Museum of Glass. The Corning Museum of Glass cares for and displays the world's best collection of art and historical glass. When you visit, you'll see more than 3,500 years of history displayed in the Glass Collection Galleries. Glass is brought to life through live, narrated glassmaking demonstrations. A catered light lunch will be provided before moving on to the next stop on the tour, the Rockwell Museum.

The Rockwell Museum is the only Smithsonian Affiliate in Upstate New York. Housed in the beautifully restored 19th-century Historic Old City Hall in Corning, The Rockwell lays at the heart of the greater Finger Lakes fine arts community. The Rockwell Museum tells the story of the American experience through fine art. The diverse collection includes a mix of nineteenth-century American paintings, historic bronzes, and Indian artifacts as well as twentieth-century modernists, illustration art, and contemporary photography. Featured galleries represent the works of Andy Warhol, the Taos Society of Artists, and masterworks of Remington and Russell.

On your return to Rochester, you will travel through the Finger Lakes Region, stopping at Keuka Springs winery. For 30 years, Keuka Spring has been consistently recognized for excellence. Their wine list includes wines for every taste, handcrafted from vineyard to bottle. Enjoy their premium wines while taking in the panoramic beauty of Keuka Lake. During your visit relax, have fun, and taste the best New York State has to offer!
